

Saturday, Oct 3rd

Medano Primitive Road (East to West)
-Rendezvous: 1030-1100 @ Hunters Camp up Co Rd 559

Directions from Alamosa ~ 2.5 Hours (Total):

- US Hwy 160 east from Alamosa to Walsenburg
 Directions from Walsenburg ~ 1.25 Hours:
- CO Hwy 69 North, west from Walsenburg
- CO Hwy 69 for ~34.2ml
- Left Onto County Road 559 (@ WARNING KEEP OUT sign)





- Co Rd 559 for ~0.9ml; keep left at 'Y'
- After 'Y'; stay on Co Rd 559 for ~6.3ml
- Stage at Hunters Camp pull-off; you should see us there! ***If you've started up a steep grade with a sharp right turn, you've gone too far***
- Trail requires high-clearance 4x4; air-down tires
- Depending on conditions/traffic, total drive time ~2.5 to 3 hours; includes time for photos/bathroom breaks
- Re-Stage at 'Tire Pressure Station' around 1300-1330

- Drive from Great Sand Dunes National Park to the Colorado Farm Brewery: drive time ~1 hour
- Fuel / Supplies found in Alamosa on your way through
- Camp @ FarmBrew opens at 1500

Sunday, Oct 4th

Blowout Pass

- Gosar Sausage Food Truck Breakfast Burritos and Solar Roast Organic Coffee from Milagros from 0700-0800
- Stage at FarmBrew ~ 0830-0900
- Convoy departs FarmBrew @ 0900 sharp
- Blowout Pass drive time ~ 3-4 hours
- End in Del Norte early that afternoon
- Re-Stage in lot at junction of Pinos Creek Road (Co Rd 14) and US Hwy 160
- Gas, food and tire pressure stations found in Del Norte
- We recommend the 1874 Food Truck, Colorado Grille or Three Barrel Brewing for lunch.
